Throughout these months of the pandemic and economic crisis, we have seen the gap widen between women's needs and the availability of services and support. Two areas where the gaps are acute are in women's health care services and in legal services for underrepresented women. Through the generosity of donors to the Resilience Fund, we have been able to provide much-needed support in these critical areas.

In the area of health care, we have been able to help improve access to health care for women whose only options are community-based programs that provide health services for free or at a greatly reduced cost. These are women who are uninsured or underinsured. Women with chronic conditions. Women in need of obstetrics and reproductive health services. Women who have suffered trauma and violence, and are in need of mental health services. In particular, these are women of color whose health has suffered in direct proportion to the impacts of the pandemic. This report highlights the outstanding work of one of our partners, Los Barrios Unidos Community Clinic, Inc., which serves a largely disenfranchised population of women of color.

In the area of legal services, we are providing support to women who are survivors of trafficking and domestic abuse. Women and girls who have been incarcerated, or suffered due to the failures of the criminal and juvenile justice systems. Women and girls who are immigrants, who are eligible for legal services but may not know their rights nor have the ability to access them due to an abusive spouse or parent. This report highlights the exceptional efforts of Lone Star Justice Alliance, one of our partners in the provision of legal services.

In October, we distributed over **\$340,000** through the Resilience Fund, bringing our total since April to more than **\$1.4 million** in responsive grants supporting women in our community. We are proud and honored to have the generous support of the Resilience Fund donors who are featured here. Yet, as we see the gaps widen and the needs expand, we ask that you continue to be part of this broad-based effort on behalf of marginalized women and families. Our support is needed now, more than ever. So we ask you to please continue to [stand with us](#), so that we stand with them – the most vulnerable women and families in our communities. Los Barrios Unidos Community Clinic, Inc.

Since 1972, Los Barrios Unidos Community Clinic has served a disenfranchised population with health, economic and social services that are also responsive to patients' language and cultural differences. The agency operates three health clinics – two in West Dallas and one in Oak Cliff. While patients can access any services at any location, it became apparent in March that there was an unmet need for safe, affordable obstetrics in Oak Cliff. Texas Women's Foundation made a grant to support a COVID-19 safe obstetrics program in the Oak Cliff clinic, an expansion of obstetrical services previously limited to the West Dallas clinic.



Lone Star Justice Alliance

Lone Star Justice Alliance seeks to improve the lives of youth and emerging adults in the justice system, addressing failures in criminal and juvenile justice. The agency launched a new program, the Survivor's Project, a collaboration between more than 30 organizations to provide pro bono legal and support services to clemency applicants ages 10 years to 24 years who have been convicted of crimes resulting from their victimization by either a trafficker or an intimate partner.

Wrap around services are provided for survivors who benefit from hope and the ability to work once convictions are removed. Texas Women's Foundation made a grant to support this program due to overwhelming need: more than 6,000 women in Texas are eligible for the program.
